The Town may request a bond to assure fund availability to repair damage to Town roads resulting from driveway construction. When bonds are requested, they shall be posted at 110% to 150% of the estimated cost to repair or restore potential damage to slopes, shoulders and pavement.

Driveway construction shall meet the requirements and definitions represented in this permit. This permit is not transferable

If the terms and conditions of this permit are violated by permit holder, and the Planning Board finds the violation constitutes a hazard to public health, safety or welfare, and upon recommendation of the Board in accordance with RSA236:13-VI, the Selectmen may institute such proceedings as it deems appropriate including the issuance of cease and desist orders pursuant to RSA 676:17-a and the issuance of citations for the commission of violations pursuant to RSA 676:17-b, to enjoin, restrain, or abate any violations of this permit and to collect penalties for such violations.






