Financial

Anne Booth proposed that we donate \$100.00 to each of the conservation organizations instead of \$75 to the Monadnock Conservancy and to SPNHF and \$80.00 to NEFF as in the past. Anne F. suggested sending the donations to a particular person with a letter stating what we accomplished in 2024, what are goals are for 2025, and ways in which we may work together (Gina's idea).

Conservation Easements

Discussed the San-Ken property on Swamp Road (Map 7 Lot-21 – 92 acres) and Anne and Anne will bring this to the attention of the Planning Board.

Cons Com members voted to hire Paul Doscher to be a consultant, meeting with landowners interested in easements. Anne Fischer moved and Belinda Backstrom seconded. Vote unanimous.
